### **THE CARTARE: A SUCCESS**

A great success for the presentation of the book *LE CARTARE DI FABRIANO Societa' Donne Lavoro nei tempi della Citta' della Carta*, was held in in Fabriano, Friday, May 31, 2013 at the Oratorio della Carità. A room packed with people looked, with enthusiasm and interest, at the first public appearance of Gianfranco Fedrigoni Foundation, *European Institute of the History of Paper and Paper Science*, and his early editorial activity. Speakers included Charles Bennati (Camerlengo della Pia Universita' dei Cartai), Alessandro Fedrigoni, President of the Fondazione G. Fedrigoni and Fedrigoni S.p.A., who presented the Foundation and its activities, and the curator of the book, Giancarlo Castagnari (Vice President of the Foundation).

It was a real success for the Foundation, for all those who collaborated in the creation of the publication, and for Fabriano, which saw the joining together of the "Cartare", papermakers of every generation and many Fabrianesi tied to a centuries-old, deeply rooted tradition. Greatly appreciated was the presence of the magnificent rector of Camerino, Flavio Corradini, who gave a talk



to enhance the diffusion of Fabriano paper which he saw, in person, on his numerous study trips abroad and of how FABRIANO paper, made him feel closer to Italy. The Mayor of Fabriano - Giancarlo Sagramola, the Culture Councillor - Giancarlo Vecerrica and the Regional Councillor of Le Marche - Patrizia Rossi, and Enzo Giancarli expressed their satisfaction with the work undertaken by the Fondazione G Fedrigoni, with the intention to perpetuate the ancient paper tradition in the city of Fabriano.
